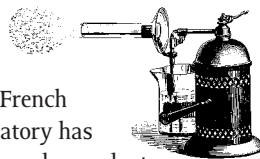

6) What wine is believed to be the oldest in the world still in production?

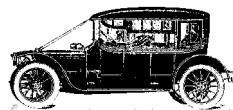


**Commandaria**
